 - Define the critical period hypothesis (2 pts)

The Critical Period Hypothesis (CPH) suggests that there is a biologically determined window during which language acquisition occurs most easily and effectively. After this period, typically ending around puberty, learning a language—especially a first language—becomes significantly more difficult and may never reach native-like proficiency.

• Prague School and Phonology (5 pts)

The Prague Linguistic Circle greatly influenced phonology by introducing the concept of distinctive features and the functional approach to sounds. They emphasized the contrastive role of phonemes in distinguishing meaning and developed the idea of binary oppositions. Notably, they viewed language as a structured system where each sound has a function in communication.
