

Master's degree in Economics & Econometrics

1. Program Description:

A Master's degree in quantitative economy is designed to intellectually prepare students to pursue Ph.D. degrees in all specialties of econometrics, and prepare students to measure the effectiveness of certain economic events or interventions. For example, it allows the graduate to be integrated into businesses as a decision-maker in economic policy. The education's goal is to assist students to obtain knowledge and abilities in economic in both its global and functional dimensions, while also instilling in them an adaptive and synthesis-minded approach.

2. Entry Requirements (Other):

The minimum bachelors rates accepted at Algerian universities are used to establish the rate at which a student must have earned their degree in order to enter the program.

Note that students are selected with a bachelor in quantitative economy, followed by the rest of the disciplines.
