The training in geography and urban planning is built around theoretical and practical content. It aims to achieve the following objectives:

- to enable students to master the main concepts of spatial planning in their geographical, economic and social dimensions;
- to introduce students to the various methods and techniques of collecting, processing and representing geographical data (statistics, cartography, GIS);
- to offer students a broad training in geography and spatial planning during the bachelor's degree cycle;
- to offer practical training in all the disciplines that make up the territory planning (urban planning, urban development, environment and operational planning).
