***Report on the United Nations

ABSTRACT

This distinct report pertains to the "Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure" component of Sustainable Development Goal 9 (SDG 9) during the years 2021 and 2022 at the University of Oum El Bouaghi.

Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure (SDG 9) - Year 2021

University Spin Offs:

In 2021, the university reported a total of 0 university spin-offs.

Research Income from Industry and Commerce:

The university received a total research income from industry and commerce of 1,064,383,950.

Research Income from Industry and Commerce by Subject Area:

- In the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) field, the research income was 565,753,580.
- There was no reported research income in the field of Medicine.
- In the Arts & Humanities / Social Sciences, the research income was 498,630,370.

Number of Employees:

The university employed a total of 1,849 individuals in various capacities.

Number of Academic Staff:

The university had 1,000 academic staff members in 2021.

Number of Academic Staff by Subject Area:

- In the STEM field, there were 480 academic staff members.
- In the field of Medicine, there were 15 academic staff members.
- In the Arts & Humanities / Social Sciences, there were 505 academic staff members.

Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure (SDG 9) - Year 2022

University Spin Offs:

In 2022, the university reported a total of 3 university spin-offs.

Research Income from Industry and Commerce:

The university received a total research income from industry and commerce of 1,082,409,468.

Research Income from Industry and Commerce by Subject Area:

- In the STEM field, the research income was 582,252,730.
- In the field of Medicine, the research income was 89,939,518.
- In the Arts & Humanities / Social Sciences, the research income was 410,217,220.

Number of Employees:

The university employed a total of 2,000 individuals in various capacities.

Number of Academic Staff:

The university had 1,100 academic staff members in 2022.

Number of Academic Staff by Subject Area:

- In the STEM field, there were 500 academic staff members.
- In the field of Medicine, there were 40 academic staff members.
- In the Arts & Humanities / Social Sciences, there were 560 academic staff members.

These statistics demonstrate positive growth in university spin-offs, research income, and staffing over the two years, particularly in STEM and the Arts & Humanities / Social Sciences. This progress aligns with the goals of SDG 9, which focuses on promoting sustainable industrialization, fostering innovation, and building resilient infrastructure. The increased number of spin-offs reflects the university's contribution to entrepreneurship and technological advancement in the region, while growth in research income highlights its collaborative efforts with industry and commerce to drive innovation and economic development.
