PAN: Personal area network connects electronic devices within a user's immediate area. It has a 10-metre range of connectivity.(1pt)

Topology: it is Physical and logical network Layout. Physical: actual layout of the computer cables and other network devices. Logical: the way in which the network appears to the devices that use it.(1pt)
