

Forum goals:

- Identify the most important issues tackled by Algerian feminine bloggers throughout the content of their blogs and their bloggins.

- Reveal the principal characteristics and traits of the feminine blogging in Algeria.

- Identify to which extent the Algerian feminine bloggers succeeded in revealing the Algerian woman concerns and issues.

Foreword:

Electronic blogging is considered as one of the phenomenon that has allowed to many citizens in the Arab region to voice and express their preoccupation and aspirations as well as taking part in criticizing political practices and public policies in the country, especially within the proliferation and the development of the right of expression throughout the different social networks that led to the existence of huge numbers of Arab bloggers who found such kind of new media an open space to express their realities and the issues that hinder them and hold their attention.

Perhaps the most striking phenomenon in these last years is the spread-out of blogging through YouTube and video platforms called Vlogging, many young bloggers from different aspirations tended to blogging since the other platforms were only reserved before to the intellectual elites. Women by their turn become able to access this virtual world, and be able to express themselves thanks to unlimited possibilities given by this communicational entity, to participate in the public virtual space which ensures freedom of opinion and expression and the engagement in the private life as well as the public one.

In Algeria women of different affiliations, cultural and intellectual levels follow in detail the daily transition of the communicational process from the general public space to the virtual one, especially via You tube and the various visual blogs, where they are principal actors in creating channels to publish whatever that contributes in defining the Algerian feminine self and its different appearances, which is indeed a reach subject to many bloggins expressed by the same platforms, in addition of being a receiver who interacts with You tube contents ,Snapshat, Instagram and other vlogs.

Most importantly for us, according to aforementioned is to search for the relationship between the Algerian woman and electronic blogging space in general, the written and the visual one, and her relationship as an actor and a subject and a receiver in this virtual space, which become able of predicting the communicational particularities' alterations within the social system from its smallest particle represented by the family to the communication in the public space.
