#### Introduction:

The present era is known as the era of the digital revolution. A revolution that involved all areas of our life; and its means penetrated into homes, schools, universities and our institutions and were preliged by people of all ages. The civilizational awareness of a country is now associated with what it owns as technologies. In the light of this invasion, literature is no longer isolated from technology, rather, new texts appeared based on the technological support, and the text shifted from the paper phase to the digital phase. This legitimate new born with different labelings : hypertext, interactive literature, digital literature, electronic literature, loghritmic literature, linked texts, ...etc which offered new stylistic standards and features that were not availble in paper literature. The fertilization between technoogy and literarure was controversial. Consequently, "a chaos in terminology and labeling is resulted, as every researcher, student or critic prefers the term suits his vision and background that knowledge, or it the country in which he lives.

#### **Conference** Issue:

This conference attempts to shed light on the digital literature, by identifying the problem of the term and concept, revealing its characteristics. production mechanisms. and receiving processing strategy, and identifying its most prominent literary genres. It also endeavors to identify Arab digital criticism mechanisms to determine whether they are derived from the digital text context ( envirement), or from the known criticism- based approaches recognised with the paper medium.

### Main Purposes:

The present conference aims at targeting the following aims :

- Discovering the relationship between literature and technology.
