The Problematic Of the Forum

The Succession of Criminal Schools has had a great impact on directing contemporary criminal policy towards reconsidering the criminalization and penalty approaches, As well as the procedural mechanisms used in managing public prosecutions, especially for some crimes, either because of their specificity or as they are classified as minor crimes, and all of this depended on ensuring the consecration of legal security in its legislative and judicial dimensions.

Countries including Algeria, were clearly affected by this trend, which is evident through its determination to decriminalize some crimes on the one hand, and reduce the severity of penalties on the other hand, whether by replacing them with others that are different in kind from those deprived of freedom due to the latter's inability to confront the criminal phenomenon, or by expanding the judge's discretionary authority in the field of introducing the criminal personality file, in addition the overcrowding of the judicial authorities and the large number of cases necessitated a move towards adopting new procedural mechanisms to facilitate the settlement of disputes in amicable ways and in short terms whether through reconciliations or mediation ... even if it was related to the penal artical.

From this standpoint. the importance of studying the topic of « **Criminal Policy Directives In Algeria Between the Legal Security and Criminal Justice Requirements** » Emerged.

It was necessary for the criminal policy of states in general and Algeria in particular to re-establish their strategy in the field of combating crime, by searching for new mechanisms that verily, on the one hand, the requirement of legal security, and on the other hand guarantee the maximum effectiveness in the face of exacerbation of the criminal phenomenon while ensuring the maximum possible protection of rights, interests and freedoms and by the last and most effective means and costs in achieving criminal justice.

In this context, the main problem of the topic of the forum revolves around :

What is the strategy chosen by Algeria in its criminal policy and how effective is it in consolidating the requirements of legal security and achieving criminal justice ?.

Objectives of the Forum:

Through research on the topic : « Trends Criminal Policy Directives In Algeria Between the Legal Security and Criminal Justice Requirements » to achieve a number of objectives, the most important of which are :

-highlighting the most important trends of contemporary criminal policy in Algeria in the substantive field in its part related to the policy of decriminalization or reduction of punishment and what is required to achieve legal security in this context.

To examine the trends of contemporary criminal policy in Algeria in the procedural field, especially those relating to summary

Procedures, which are being actively pursued in criminal cases, without prejudice to the requirements of criminal justice. Presenting and analyzing the models of some legislation in this regard. Evaluating the criminal policy of the Algerian legislator in both the substantive and procedural fields, and then confirming the extent of its effectiveness in consolidating the requirement of legal security and achieving criminal justice in its highest forms and meanings.

Themes of the forum:

-The first axis: The conceptual framework (defining criminal policy and its various trends, controlling the requirements of legal security, both legislative and judicial, determining the meaning of criminal justice and its requirements...).

-The second axis: The orientation of contemporary criminal policy in Algeria at the objective level.

First: Contemporary mechanisms to reduce criminalization.

Second: Contemporary mechanisms to reduce punishment

-The third axis: Contemporary criminal policy in Algeria at the procedural level.

(Summary procedures and their most important applications in Algerian

legislation: the criminal reconciliation system, the reconciliation system, the penal order system, the criminal mediation system...).

-The fourth axis: The effectiveness of contemporary criminal policy in Algeria in consolidating the requirements of legal security and achieving criminal justice (evaluation of the Algerian legislature's criminal policy, whether in the substantive or procedural field).
